



## Keratinocyte Medium-defined-basal (KM-d-b)

### Product Description

Keratinocyte Medium-defined-basal (KM-d-b) is a basal medium designed for optimal growth of normal human dermal-derived keratinocytes *in vitro* in conjunction with defined keratinocyte growth supplement (KGS-d, Cat. No. 2162) and penicillin/streptomycin solution (P/S, Cat. No. 0503). KM-d-b is a sterile, liquid medium which contains essential and non-essential amino acids, vitamins, organic and inorganic compounds, and trace minerals. The basal medium does not contain antimycotics, antibiotics, hormones, growth factors or proteins. The medium is bicarbonate buffered and has a pH of 7.4 when equilibrated in an incubator with an atmosphere of 5% CO<sub>2</sub>/95% air.

### Product Use

KM-d-b is for research use only. It is not approved for human or animal use, or for application in *in vitro* diagnostic procedures.

### Storage

Store at 4°C. Protect from light.
